

(prayer) **Rooms** (*blessing, movement*)

We encourage any church or group to host their own prayer Room, 24-7 or otherwise.

We resource prayer Rooms openly through books (*Red Moon Rising*, etc), with phone-calls/emails (when churches/groups register via our websites), with web-articles and podcasts (*Prayer Spaces*, etc) and through various gatherings (e.g. *The Feast*).

Where national prayer teams exist, these are responsible for supporting prayer Rooms. In nations where a national team doesn't yet exist, the International prayer team (Carla Harding) is responsible for supporting prayer Rooms.

Rhythms of prayer, meals, mission, etc. (*blessing...*)

We encourage any group of friends to develop Christ-centred Rhythms of life, foremost in prayer. Some may call themselves '24-7 (or Mustard Seed) communities'. We resource these Rhythms freely with books, phone calls/emails, web-articles (incl. the OMS website?) and podcasts, and through gatherings. We also offer \$\$\$ learning/training opportunities (e.g. *web-learning*).

Where they exist, national (prayer) teams and Boiler Rooms are primarily responsible for encouraging groups who are practising Rhythms of life... until they express desire to become a 24-7prayer Boiler Room. This begins the *courtship*.

the **courtship**... begins when a group or '24-7/Mustard Seed community' wants to become a 24-7prayer Boiler Room (see '*New Communities: from Enquiry to ongoing Engagement*'). (We need to clarify the courtship process...)

Wherever possible, Boiler Room Centres are responsible for supporting Boiler Rooms and helping them to develop healthily, in co-operation with national teams.

Boiler Rooms, in **Relationship** (*building, family*)

We warmly welcome communities who have courted with us, into Relationship. We consider these to be family. We carry some responsibility for and with them. We resource these Boiler Rooms with coaching and mentoring and direct involvement, with learning/training opportunities (e.g. *web-learning*, *Springboard*, other leadership training) and with specific gatherings.

The International Communities Team is responsible for supporting Boiler Room Centres, in co-operation with national teams.

Boiler Room Centres, **Resource** to others (*building...*)

We look to establish Boiler Room Centres, those who can be a Resource to others (Boiler Rooms, '24-7 communities', etc), and to plant/send people out. BRCs are family. We carry responsibility for and with them. We resource these Boiler Room Centres with coaching and mentoring and direct involvement, and in their hosting of learning/training opportunities (e.g. *Transit*).
